### ONE DAY STATE LEVEL SEMINAR ON RESTITUTION OF CHILD RIGHTS IN INDIA

A One day State Level Seminar on 'Restitution of Child Rights in India' (RCRI-2015) was organised on Saturday 19, December 2015 by Social Science Forum in the portals of Aggarwal College Ballabgarh under the patronage of Director Higher Education, Haryana. Around 100 scholars, thinkers, academicians & research scholars from Haryana and its neighbouring states had deliberated on the various aspects of the topic and provided food for thought. This showed the wide acceptance of the topic and the dire necessity for its immediate redressal.

In the Inauguration Ceremony, the theme of the Seminar was presented by Dr. Ashok Nirala, the Convener of the Seminar in which he presented data showing the miserable condition of the children in India. He expressed his concern over the need for complete transformation in the system and he desired for having a concrete solution to the problems and challenges put forth by the delegates & speakers. Keynote Speaker Dr. Nuzhat Parveen



Khan, faculty of Law, JMI, New Delhi talked about Child Right violation in which emotional maltreatment was stressed on. She said that a nation's future depends upon what its children become when they grow up as citizens. She opined that right to free and compulsory education should be made available to children from 3 to 18 years instead of 6-14 years. She suggested that Govt. should have to undertake big projects for rehabilitation of children as they comprise 50% of population of India. She also told about Juvenile Protection Officers and various



infrastructural benefits of Govt. for the welfare of children hitherto unknown. Chief Guest Mr. Devender Gupta, President, Aggarwal College, Ballabgarh in his address said that the foremost basic necessity of Right to food for children should be addressed first as this is the root cause of turning them into criminals. He motivated all present to do something practical to bring about a radical change in the pitiable condition of children such as providing skill based education to them and by opening more such schools. Principal Dr. Krishan Kant in his speech said that child is not an absolute rather a relative term and that rights of a child begin right from the womb to the tomb. He further said that the rights of the children are the basic needs that include secure environment, nutrition and freedom from domestic violence.

In the Valedictory Session, Ms. Ritu, Organising Secretary of the Seminar presented the Summary of the Seminar. Dr. Anisur Rahman presented the Valedictory Address in which he touched the sensitive issue of child labour. He mentioned about protection



of children from being employed in hazardous employment, protection against emotional and material abandonment and provisions of free and compulsory education. Mr. Gopal Sharma Advocate, a social activist, raised the consciousness of the people present and motivated them to start the reforms from the grassroots level i.e. the children as they are vulnerable and need special care and protection.
