

## **PRESS RELEASE**

On the **2<sup>ND</sup> Day** i.e. 21<sup>st</sup> August 2018, the 5-Day Workshop on Global Economic Awareness Project organised by America led 05-member team, the students of Economics of Aggarwal College Ballabgarh had a comprehensive and detailed discussion on Macroeconomics and Applications. The speakers - Ms. Shreya Gupta, Mr. Scott Williams & Ms. Gabriella Almeida, had a healthy interaction with 80 students divided into 2 groups. They discussed about the application of Macroeconomics on everyday life, key macro indicators and monetary and fiscal policies. Dr. Manoj Shukla, Convener of the workshop told that the discussions on all the major aspects of Macro Economics will prove quite fruitful. It will make the students comprehend the monetary policies of Govt. of India and Reserve Bank of India. Dr. Usha Chaudhary and Ms. Shubhra told that the students are divided into 2 groups and through Game Theory, they were made to understand the basic tenets of Economics. The workshop is conducted under Mr. Mathew Almeida, Workshop Captain, GEA Project, USA and Mr. Aadil Chitalawala, Head of Project-India, GEA Project, USA.

On the same day a guest lecture on 'Nobel Laureates' was organised for the PG students of the college by Ms. Kiran Anand. The keynote speaker Ms. Indira Mohan is a renowned poet, social activist and has contributed essays, write-ups to major journals and newspapers. She elaborated in detail about the genesis and growth of Nobel, Founder Sir Alfred Nobel, her life journey, moment of her transformation and the eventual gift given by her to the World. Moral values never change even in changing times. On the **4<sup>th</sup> day** of the Global Economic Awareness Project being held in Aggarwal College Ballabgarh from 20th August to 24th August 2018 organised by Department of Economics in collaboration with GEA Project, USA, the students were divided into groups of 5 members each and were given training for Power Point Presentation on the topic 'Urbanisation' for which they were also provided case study. On the same day, a Slogan Writing Competition was also organised by Deptt. of Sanskrit under the Sanskrit Saptah (from 23rd to 29th August, 2018) as directed by Director Higher Education, Haryana. Under this various activities will be organised throughout the week such as Slogan Writing, Poetic Recitation of Shlokas etc.

The **5<sup>TH</sup> day** long Workshop on Global Economic Awareness being conducted in Aggarwal College Ballabgarh from 20th to 24th August, 2018 concluded today with the Valedictory Ceremony. This Workshop was being organised by Department of Economics in collaboration with Global Economic Awareness Project, USA led by 5-member team of Mr. Matthew Almeida, Ms. Aadil Chitalwal, Mr. Scott Williams, Ms. Gabriella Almeida and Ms. Shreya Gupta. They interacted with 80 students in

groups of 2 and students were taught the basic tenets of Macro and Micro Economics and their applications in the firms. The students presented their PPTs on 'Rapid Urbanisation' on the last day of the Workshop and the 2 winner teams were felicitated.
