12.1 Opening remarks by the Hon'ble Principal Dr. Krishan Kant, Chairman IQAC and Welcome to the members of IQAC

Principal Dr. Krishan Kant, Chairman IQAC welcomed the members of IQAC.

12.2 Confirmation of the minutes of the 11th meeting of IQAC held on 13th Dec, 2014.

Considered the minutes of the 11^{th} meeting of IQAC held on 13-12-2014 (Annexure- A/)

Resolved that the minutes of the 11th meeting of the IQAC held on 13-12-2014 be confirmed.

12.3 Report of the follow up of action on the decision taken by the IQAC in its 11th meeting held on 13-12-2014

The House noted the follow up action on the decisions taken in its 11^{th} meeting.

12.4 To consider the new initiatives and practices in college

12.4.1 To prepare Annual Calendar

The House was apprised of that the Annual Calendar Part-I (July to Dec. 2015) was successfully implemented. Academic Calendar Part-II (Jan. 2016 to June 2016) was considered and it was suggested that day should be mentioned along with date and that internal House Test dates should also be incorporated in the calendar.

12.4.2 **To arrange classes for slow learners**

The IQAC expressed its concern to improve the performance of students results. It was decided that BA First year students be tested after 3 weeks of commencement of classes and weak students will be put into special classes.

Remedial coaching classes for SC/ BC will be restarted and classes for compartment students will also be initiated for which we have received a grant from UGC.

The House was informed about tutorials, special classes for slow learners and House Tests taken to improve the academic performance of the students.

Prof. Chakarvarti expressed his concern to take up tutorials as seriously as the regular classes.

Mr. Lokesh stressed on the need for mentoring and that weak and non serious students be motivated to be regular in classes.

12.4.3 **To conduct a Workshop on Faculty Development**

It was decided that faculty wise workshop in small groups (20-25) will be organized under the coordinatorship of Dr. Sachin Garg to make effective use of ICT facilities and e learning content available in the college. It was decided that some external experts will be invited to impart training for use of smartboards and e books.

12.4.4 (a) To organize classes for preparation for competitive examinations

The House wanted to have a database to know about the number of placements in each year. For this it was decided

that a performa be designed and filled at the time of farewell party of students to know their interests and during the Convocation Function. It was decided that external agencies should be hired and they will be paid on lecture basis.

12.4.4 (b) The cell was informed that besides 6 PG classes, two more PG classes in English & Chemistry are commencing from next session i.e. 2016-17.

12.4.5 To highlight the achievements and contributions of great leaders

It was decided that guest lectures and competitions on contributions of great leaders should be made part of routine Academic Calander.

12.4.6 **To organize National Conference/ Workshop/ Seminar**

The IQAC laid emphasis on organizing more Conferences and Workshops to encourage the research aptitude of the teachers & students. It was also decided that more UGC MRPs should be taken up by the teachers.

12.4.7 **To make Internal Evaluation System more productive**

It was decided that a student who tops in subjects should be awarded with the condition that he has got minimum 60% marks and has appeared in and passed all subjects. Office is being entrusted the duty of giving the information regarding the students' performance. The notice regarding award and list of toppers of each subject should be displayed well in time.

12.4.8 To arrange special classes for preparation for UGC NET Examinations

It was resolved that the coaching for preparation of UGC NET would be provided to PG students for which there will external agencies who will be paid on the basis of lectures.

12.5 Any other item with the permission of the Hon'ble Chairman, IQAC

It was decided that the next IQAC meeting will be held on February 20, 2016 with the agenda to look at various recommendations of NAAC and to draw a roadmap for the next three years which will be the basis for next NAAC inspection, which will help to improve upon the Excellency achieved earlier and go to the next level i.e. Centre for Excellence.
