

As per the guidelines from DGHE Haryana, Women Cell Aggarwal College Ballabgarh organised various programmes under the campaign 'Ek Aur Sudhar' for women safety and empowerment and gender sensitization from 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2018 to 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. On 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2018 Slogan Writing Competition and Group Discussion 'Bindas Bol' were organised. On 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 a Special Assembly on gender sensitization was organised in which Dr. Alok Deep, Social Activist was the keynote speaker.
