Skill Development among Students

Aggarwal College Ballabgarh in association with Haryana Vishwakarma Skill University, Gurugram for the computer graduates and post-graduates of the college, have started from 20th June, 2018. This was the information imparted by Principal Dr. Krishan Kant. He also told that 'Skill Development is the need of the hour in the present scenario besides bookish knowledge'. For that purpose recently an MoU has been signed between Aggarwal College and Haryana Vishwakarma Skill University, Gurugram under which expert teachers will be training the students in a batch of 30 each regarding personality development and behavioural skills under a fixed curriculum from 16th May, 2018. In this 5 day workshop, important skills such as soft skills, Role Plays, Active Listening, Pronunciation, Grammar, Telephone etiquette, Email Writing, Facing Interviews etc. will be taught. These skills are the basic requirement of graduates (BA, B.Com, BCA, BBA, BBA CAM) which will help them to face the interviews with more confidence. These classes are being provided free of cost in the college. Students are quite enthusiastic to participate in this. Ms. Kamal Tandon, Ms. Kiran Anand, Dr. Naresh Kamra, Dr. Rekha Sain, Dr. Parveen Gupta, Dr. Sachin Garg and Dr. Shilpa Goel are coordinating in this workshop. By May 16, 2018 to June 19, 2018, students of B.A. and B.Com have been trained. Training education has been started for the students of Computer Department from 20th June, 2018 in which students of BCA, B.Voc (Software Development) and M.Sc. (Computer Science) are participating. These classes will take place from June 20, 2018 to June 26, 2018, after which training classes will be started for the Management Department students.
