Convocation and Annual Prize Distribution Function (13.04.2019)

A Convocation and Prize Distribution Function were organised at Aggarwal College Ballabgarh in its premises on 13th April, 2019. The Chief Guest for the programme was Hon'ble Mr. Justice Ramendra Jain of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Chandigarh. Former Chairman of Aggarwal Vidya Pracharni Sabha and Chairman Advisory Committee Lala Ratan Singh Gupta, President Sh. Devender Kumar Gupta, Principal Dr. Krishan Kant Gupta and members college Governing Body graced the occasion. The college fraternity teaching and non-teaching faculty as well as the students were also present.

On this day, 1895 students were awarded with graduate and post graduate degrees along with students having positions in university Merit List. This included 379 degrees (Arts),796 (Commerce),468 (Sciences), 108 (Computer Science) and 144 (Management) department. The programme commenced with lighting of the lamp. Dr. Krishan Kant Gupta welcomed the guests by presenting bouquets and delivered the Annual Report of the college. He also gave a brief information about various activities organised by clubs and fora of the institution. He also made the audience aware about the efforts of Aggarwal Vidya Pracharini Sabha which made financial contribution to the students who were unable to pay their fees. This includes the contribution of Rs. Rs. 77 Lacs 33000 in session 2015-16, Rs. 1 Crore 26 Lacs 89000 in session 2016-17 and Rs. 1 Crore 37 Lacs 50000 in session 2017-18.

Students from all departments like Arts, Commerce, Computers, management were also presented with their degrees. . A one of its kind college Anthem was also launched which was highly applauded by the Chief Guest. The Chief Guest Sh. Ramendra Jain in his Convocation Speech cited to the audience the narrative of Guru Dronacharya and the relevance of Guru-Shishya relationship. He went on to state that the students should work hard ,obey their teachers and aim big in life before ending his speech. After that the procession retreated and Annual Prize Distribution function followed.

In the Prize distribution function 539 prizes were given away to students who have excelled in Academics, Sports and Co-Curricular activities. Ms. Nancy was awarded Smt. Kishan Dei gold Medal for standing First in college in B.A III.Ms. Sushma got ACB Alumni Gold Medal Award for topping in B. Com III . Sagwa

Mal Mangla Gold Medal for Science was awarded to Sh. Bobby Kaushik. Sh.P.P Dureja award was awarded jointly to Ms. Neha and Ms.Jyoti Bisla for getting highest marks in English B.A III. Our 229 students got positions in University Merit List, out of which 17 students were on first position, 15 students on second position and 14 students were on third position were also felicitated along with our sports star Anmol Jain. He has won various international laurels in shooting by getting gold medals in different competitions. He made proud not only Ballabgarh but our nation also by winning silver and bronze medals in tournaments held in Japan and Germany. Our students who have also carved a niche in weightlifting, Baseball, Softball ,Taekwondo, Boxing, Judo and Archery by winning prizes at various national and international levels were also awarded. The occasion also saw the unveiling of ACB Newsletter- a quarterly magazine having signature events of the college.

The President Mr. Devender Kumar Gupta spoke about the need not to pressurise students and encourage them to recognise their own individual talents. He went on to add that unnecessary pressure and comparisons with peers doesn't do any good to overall development of the students. Therefore ,the need is to motivate them to aim for the highest goals in life always. The Principal in his speech stated that Aggarwal College Ballabgarh has always worked for the community by awarding the meritorious and deserving students. He also said that the institution has made constant efforts to promote transparency by introducing students portal . The various cultural items like dances, songs and Halla Bol skit by team Bati etc. were also interspersed in the prize distribution event.
