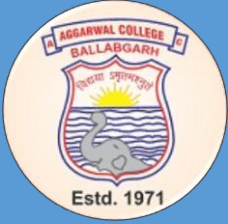

### **ABOUT US**

Aggarwal College Ballabgarh (Estd. 1971), is a post graduate co-educational institution affiliated to M.D. University, Rohtak. It is situated in Ballabgarh, Distt. Faridabad on NH-2, a part of the National Capital Region and is approx 45 km from Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. The college is running 7 under graduate, 5 Hons. and 8 post graduate courses. Besides this six add-on courses and two vocational degree courses sponsored by University Grants Commission, New Delhi are also being run to equip students with market oriented innovative skills.

- The proceedings of the conference shall be unveiled in the Inaugural Session of the conference.
- An edited book with ISBN number shall be published in due course of time subject to availability of sufficient number of papers.
- Shortlisted participants shall be asked to submit their full paper for publication in edited book.
