

Under the direction of Maharishi Dayanand University Rohtak, Tree Plantation Fortnight is being celebrated from July 14, 2022 to July 28, 2022 in Aggarwal College Ballabgarh. Under this initiative Women Cell, Department of Economics and English organized a programme on 15 July 2022, on the occasion of World International Justice Day. College Principal Dr. Krishan Kant informed that volunteers of various units of Aggarwal College like NSS, SDGs Club, and YRC will actively participate in this tree plantation programme. He said that the District Forest Department officer made a special contribution and provided 500 saplings, which will be planted in the courtyard of Aggarwal College and various schools adopted under the community outreach program and the surrounding area. Various competitions will also be organized under Tree Plantation Fortnight like poster making, slogan writing, essay writing, poetry recitation and speech competition in which students will be made aware about the importance of plantation. Aggarwal Public School, Sector-3 has been adopted by Aggarwal College Ballabgarh under the community outreach program in which World International Justice Day was celebrated. This day is celebrated every year on 17th July with the aim of promoting social justice globally without discrimination. On this occasion, a poster making competition was organized for the students, the themes of which were: - "Social Justice and Equality", "Social Justice and Human Rights". For this, she also provided helpline numbers 112 and 1091. She also assured the girl students that if they face any kind of problem, they can come to the Women's Police Station Ballabgarh to meet them and tell their problems, it will be resolved and also assured confidentiality. Two Constables Ms. Sushma Ms. Rajani explained various self-defense techniques to the girl students and also gave detailed information about Durga Shakti App. In the poster making

competition, Kumari Neha Chaudhary got first position, Tanya got second place and Himanshi got third place. Rimjhim and Khushi were given consolation prizes.
