Online Workshop on "Research Methodology" organised by Department of Mathematics, Aggarwal College Ballabgarh

An Online Workshop on "Research Methodology" was organised by Department of Mathematics, Aggarwal College Ballabgarh on 17.02.2023 under the able guidance of Principal Dr. Krishan Kant. Dr. Mohd.Javed Idrisi, Associate Professor, Mizan -Tepi University, Ethiopia was the keynote speaker. Recently, on 29th Dec 2022, an MOU has also been signed between Aggarwal College Ballabgarh and Mizan -Tepi University, Ethiopia. The workshop started with the welcome address by Dr. K.L Kaushik, (Convener), H.O.D, Department of Mathematics. The main objective of this workshop was to enlighten the students about the theoretical and practical aspects of doing research. After the lecture, the students put their curiosity in front of the keynote speaker by asking questions and the attendee answered them with great pleasure. Mathematics Department also organized a Seminar on "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)" on 16.02.2023 in which Mr. Vinay Yadav, GST, Income Tax and IPR Consultant was the keynote speaker. Mr. Vinay Yadav told the students that Intellectual property rights (IPR) are the creations of mind or intellectual works that are protected by law. He discussed the seven types of IPR include patents, trademarks, copyrights, trade secrets, geographical indications, industrial designs and plant variety rights.
